From The Director


Welcome winter!

CES is fortunate to have many amazing employers! One employer will be highlighted each quarter.

Our employer of the month is Laketrans!

Laketrans has been the provider of transportation for most of our individuals for more than 30 years. Five years ago we were awarded the contract to clean all Laketrans busses and their building. This partnership has only grown over the years and now with the expansion and renovation of the Laketrans building, we will be able to hire more individuals and

expand our scope of work. Deepwood Industries individuals clean the entire fleet of vehicles, including the Dial-A-Rides, Commuter and fixed route busses. Recently Laketrans has started to convert its local, fixed route busses to electric, which will be easier on the environment and also help save money. The Laketrans building is part way through a more than \$20 million renovation and expansion, updating every facet of the building as well as the bus garage. As Laketrans increases ridership in Lake County,

their needs also increase and they are committed to a state of the art facility and fleet, as good stewards of the communities tax dollars.
