JOB COACH RECOGNITION

We sometimes forget the unsung heroes behind the scenes who help supervise our individuals and train them to be great employees. CES has six job coaches and two job support specialists as well as three substitutes who oversee 12 group employment sites. We will highlight two of them each quarter here. This quarter is Gail Brugh and Tim Franke.

Gail Brugh has been with the agency for quite a long time. She started in CES as a substitute job coach then went to the residence to work and came back to CES as a Job Support Specialist. Gail has run many of our sites and does a great job. She is currently running one of our sites at Silco. She has 3 individuals who package silicone caulking of different sizes, labels them, make the boxes and prepares them to be shipped out.

Tim Franke has been with the agency for many years as well. He worked in the Willoughby Workshop before coming over to CES to be a job coach. Tim has run several of our sites and does a great job building rapport with our individuals and their families. He is currently running Center for Pastoral Leadership or CPL as we call it. He supervises a group of 4-5 individuals in the kitchen. Tasks include dishwashing, restocking shelves and machines, set ups for lunch and dinner as well as making sure the dietary area is clean and disinfected.
